  - 18% The state government should strictly mandate statewide rules to keep people inside their homes and shut down additional businesses in my community so we can stop the spread of the virus.
  - 77% It is fine to loosen restrictions on businesses so people can get back to work and provide for their families as long as strict health and safety guidelines are met.
