Re-open Plan

Effective June 1, 2020

Step 1 June 1-14 Mass gathering limited to 30 people

Step 2 June 15-28 Mass gathering limited to 45 people

Step 3 June 29 Mass gathering limits lifted

All businesses in Stanton County are allowed to open with respect to the following:

- ✓ Practice Social Distancing
- ✓ Practice thorough hand washing using soap and water or hand sanitizer
- ✓ Wear a mask when in public (Recommended)
- ✓ High Risk Individuals-continue to Stay at Home (Recommended)

Stanton County Officials will determine continued guidance based on Pandemic Activity in our area; plus, our capacity to provide health services, disease investigation and control of those infected with or exposed to COVID-19.

If current guidelines prove ineffective, they will be altered for the protection of our community.

*Many businesses & facilities will receive guidance from their licensing or parent organization; or prefer to impose stricter, guidelines. Please comply with these.

*Those under Isolation or Quarantine Restrictions will continue to be advised and contacted by the Stanton County Health Department and the Stanton County Sheriff.
